## **ACTION TAKEN REPORT**

## IQAC 2022-2023

Date: 26th August 2023

IQAC conducted 4 meetings in the year 2022-2023 wherein the members contemplated and discussed on several academic and administrative aspects of the institute with the intention of adding value to various stakeholders of the institute. The following actions were taken up by the institute

As per the suggestions of IQAC pre conference workshops were conducted as a part of IMBRC 2022. This ensured that there was some value addition as compared to the earlier conference which was the debut attempt of the IMBRC. The pre conference workshops were designed with the intention of helping participants publish their papers in reputed journals and included topics like identifying topic of research, identifying journals for publication, handling review and revision process and forging collaborations for research. The pre conference workshops were well received by the participants

As per the suggestions of the faculty members who are part of IQAC, A four day online FDP program on Structured Equation Modeling was conducted between 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> April 2023. This was to instill confidence in faculty members as contemporary research methods are preferred for publication of paper in research journals. The faculty members of the institute and other members who attended the FDP were benefitted from this FDP

In addition to FDP, the institute conducted certifications and workshops for the students as well. These certifications were over and above the regular certifications conducted by the institute. These certifications included six sigma certifications conducted for 11 students on 9<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Dec 2022. Further Dr. Ritesh Kumar, core faculty, Human Resource Management conducted workshop on HR analytics for HR students of FCRIMS

The institute rebooted its events that were either paused due to COVID or had moved to online mode. The annual fest ABSTRACT was conducted in Jan 2023 in a completely offline mode and students had hands on experience of organizing an event. Similarly activities like FABS market, Union Budget Seminar, IIC initiatives were conducted in offline mode in the year 2022-2023

The semester 4 projects that are a part of the curriculum of University of Mumbai were executed with higher rigor specifically the Social Relevance project. In the last academic year, the students had merely studied CSR activities undertaken by various companies and was more of a desk project. This year the students undertook a practical project like organizing health care camps in orphanage, elderly homes and also mangrove cleaning project.
